When you reach the office, tell them you are with American Legend Corvette Club and then they will make your reservation with your personal credit card. The rate is \$115/night. Some rooms have a king bed and some rooms have a double bed. We reserved the last 11 rooms that they had. (This is a very big weekend in Mt. Airy and most all hotels are already sold out.) Reservations must be made by September 1st at which time the rooms will be released. Cancellations can be made up to 6 p.m. on the 27th. Continental breakfast is included. Rooms have hair dryers, irons and ironing boards. Some rooms have coffee pots. There is an outdoor pool. Directions, I-77, exit 101 (I-74 east). 8 miles to exit 11 (hwy 601), turn left at light.
